References may be submitted on the attached form and/or may be submitted as a formal letter of support (not to exceed two pages each). The person submitting the nomination may also be one of the three references.

Substantiating materials may also be submitted; however, CDs, DVDs and videos will not be accepted. Nominations and substantiating materials will not be returned.

The maximum number of pages that can be submitted is 10 (ten) including the application.

The Judges will refer to the Mission Statement and categories above when considering the nominees. You may use this as a guide when filling out a reference or submitting a letter of support. Winners will be notified in January 2017.

Nominations must be received by January 6, 2017.
